The Lockheed Martin LCS Concept and Design Center (CaDC) brings the Littoral Combat Ship solution to life. This multi-media center steps through the development of the Lockheed Martin LCS solution, from conception to detailed design and construction. A walk through the CaDC takes visitors through the features, characteristics, and concept of operations of the LM LCS design.

The CaDC allows the LCS team of Lockheed Martin, Gibbs & Cox, Marinette Marine, and Bollinger Shipyards to demonstrate the solution to visitors, as well as refine the design with the Navy. On display at the center are “working” scale models of the aviation and watercraft areas of the ship and the mission modules, which demonstrate

the launch and recovery of various air, surface and sub-surface vehicles on the LCS. In addition, the “A Month-in-the-Life of an LCS” video illustrates the current and future operations of the LCS. Video footage of the ship’s model testing at Carderock and the aviation launch & recovery system testing at Naval Air Warfare Center (NAWC) in Lakehurst are available. Furthermore, the center has on display the latest construction

status, including detailed photos of the ship’s progress at the shipyard. The LCS program team is available to answer questions and provide in-depth tours of the facility.

By Metro:

Take the green line to the Navy Yard metro stop. Exit the New Jersey Ave. side of the metro station. Walk four blocks east on M Street. 300 M Street will be the building on your left, between 3rd and 4th Streets.

Parking:

The entrance to our garage is on 4th Street. Parking is available at a rate of \$7/hour or \$15/day.

By Car:

From Dulles Airport:

Take Rt. 267 East (Dulles Toll Rd.). Continue on I-66 East towards Washington. Take the Rt. 110 South Exit 75 towards Pentagon/Alexandria. Continue on Jefferson Davis Hwy for 2.2 miles. Bear right onto I-395 North toward Washington. Follow directions “From the South.”

From Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport:

Take George Washington Memorial Parkway North. Take I-395 North towards Washington. Follow directions “From the South.”

From the South:

Take I-395 North towards Washington. Continue on I-295 South. Take the South Capitol Street exit. Turn left at M Street. 300 M Street on your left, between 3rd and 4th Streets. See “Parking”.

From the North:

Take MD-295 South (Baltimore-Washington Parkway) and continue onto I-295 South. Take the Howard Road Exit 3B towards Downtown. Turn right onto Howard Road. Merge left onto South Capitol St. SE and continue over the Anacostia River. Keep right at the fork to continue on South Capitol Street. Turn right onto M Street. 300 M Street on your left, between 3rd and 4th Streets. See “Parking”.
